Dear Members,

The escalation of the Coronavirus has prompted us to make prudent choices for the well-being of our members and guests. Our prayerful consideration of information from the U.S. Surgeon General, Centers for Disease Control and the Louisiana Governor, has prompted our decision to temporarily suspend services at Franklin Street Church of Christ, consistent with the Governor's public health emergency recommendation for 30 day closures and limiting public gathering. We hope to resume normal worship on April 19, 2020. Thank you for your prayers and understanding as we make choices that are best for our physical and spiritual health, while serving as responsible leaders in the interest of our community. Please follow the guidance offered in the notes below. Remember – God is with us!

1. Prepare to worship the Lord at your home on the first day of the week.
2. Communion Availability: Beginning this Saturday, March 21, 2020, we have set up a "drive-through" service at the church building. Members can drive to the front of the building and receive a self-contained communion serving for you to consume on Sunday. You may also drop off your offering. 10am – Noon.
3. Financial Contributions: The expenses of the church continue, even though our choices regarding physically assembling may make it inconvenient to give. We encourage members to mail checks or money orders to the church building or drop off your contributions when you come for your communion on Saturday. You can drop off cash or checks. This will be from 10am to Noon.
4. Sunday Sermons: We will record the sermons and they will be available for you to listen on Sunday mornings at www.fscoc.com and click on sermons at the top.
5. Please make special efforts to be attentive to information and to sharing with members who may not have ready access to electronic modes of communication.
6. The decision to suspend our physically assembled worship services is being reviewed continuously and we will provide updated information as necessary. Thank you for praying continuously.
